Information page concerning the documents required the safety mark (S) or the evidence

According to Chapter 3, art. 16 and 17 of the ordinance on electrical low voltage equipment (NEV; RS 734.26), the following documents are required for the application of the safety mark S:

## Safety

- Certificate of Conformity resp. test report by a CCA-/CB-/EAL-, a Swiss or a foreign testing body which is accredited according to standard ISO/IEC 17000 series for electrical safety according to international standard EN/IEC (in one of the official Swiss languages or in English)
- Test report for Swiss deviations

## EMC / EMF

• Declaration of Conformity (in one of the official Swiss languages or in English) which confirms that the equipment completely fulfills the obligations of the applicable international standards EN/CISPR/IEC for radio interference suppression, disturbances in power supply systems, immunity against disturbers and electromagnetic fields of persons EMF

or

 Test report of a CCA-/CB-/EAL, a Swiss or foreign testing body which is accredited according to standard ISO/IEC 17025 for radio interference suppression, disturbances in power supply system, immunity against disturbers and electromagnetic fields of persons EMF according to international standards EN/CISPR/IEC

## Additionally required documents

- Declaration of Identity (confirming the sample conformity of the equipment type .... with test report/certificate no. ....)
- Information about the Swiss plug
- · List of components with indication of the manufacturer as well as existing safety marks
- Name plate or a drawing thereof with the Swiss safety mark and indication of origin (name, city & country of the licensee, or an identification code to be assigned by us upon request, or his company logo or -trademark which can be registered with us against a fee)
- Indication of the manufacturer and if necessary the importer
- Electrical diagram
- If necessary further information from technical documentation (art. 12 NEV) in one of the official Swiss languages or in English
- Operators- / erecting manual (in one of the official Swiss languages or in English)
- Required safety information in one of the official Swiss languages
- Tradename under which the equipment will be made available on the market in Switzerland
- Photo or brochure
